The meeting was started by welcoming all the members, the agenda was discussed and actions taken are as under-

Agenda No. 1: Confirmation of the proceedings of 17th MIDH meeting.

It was instructed to all MS, DHMIUs to update the physical and financial achievement on NHM portal. MD informed the house that sub-committee meeting has been fixed on 15.11.2016, all MS, DHMIUs were instructed to submit their projects immediately at HQ. MD informed that Director of Horticulture, GOI, New Delhi may visit district Panchkula and Sonapat for monitoring of project based activities.

During review of Action taken report, the following decisions were taken:

- 3.1 In Annual Action Plan targets of 8 ha. has been allotted to district Yamunanagar under component establishment of new gardens/fruits. During the meeting targets were revised and area of 4.2 ha. was allotted to district Yamunanagar, 1 ha. to Sirsa, 2 ha. to district Rohtak and 0.8 ha. to district Ambala.

(Action taken by: MS, DHMIU Yamunanagar, Sirsa, Rohtak & Ambala)

- 3.2 During the meeting, target under Hybrid vegetables in open field of 100 ha. was surrendered by MS, DHMIU Gurgaon and same was allotted to district Jind. All MS, DHMIUs were directed to take random sampling of vegetable seeds being purchased by the farmers time to time.

(Action taken by: All MS, DHMIUs)

- 3.3 All MS, DHMIUs informed the house that under component of INM/IPM, the targets could not be achieved due to non-availability of local dealers of empaneled firms at district level. Therefore, the house has decided to allow the procurement of material pertaining to IPM/INM by MS, DHMIUs in the interest of farmers. It is mandatory to get registered the applicant on 'HORTNET' portal.

(Action taken by: All MS, DHMIUs)

- 3.4 Suptt./NHM informed the house that explanation was called of MS, DHMIU Ambala, Bhiwani, Fatehabad, Hisar, Jind, Jhajjar, Karnal, Kurukshetra, Mewat, Panipat, Panchkula, Sirsa & Yamunanagar vide letter no. 3514-26, dated 28.09.2016 for low achievements but explanation has not been submitted by MS, DHMIU Ambala, Jind, Jhajjar, Karnal, Kurukshetra, Panipat, Panchkula, Sirsa & Yamunanagar. MD instructed concerned MS, DHMIUs to submit their explanation.

3.5 The manufacturing of LS Bee-Hives could not be started at IBDC, Ramnagar due to non-availability of NOC to run saw machine. Keeping in view the ongoing season & demand from field it was decided that the Bee-keepers may be allowed to purchase Bee-Hives from the firms empanelled by the Director General Horticulture, Haryana, Panchkula last year. Further, it was clarified that this component is reserved for SC beneficiaries. In this regard, a seniority list may be maintained at district level on first come first serve basis. The data of all beneficiaries should be seeded in HORTNET portal for release of assistance through payment gateway system.

Agenda No. 4: Review of progress of SCSP component under MIDH scheme up to October, 2016.

MD instructed all MS, DHMIUs to send the report in Performa, so that progress can be reviewed.

Agenda No. 5: Brief Power-point Presentation on protected structure by DHCs.

MD instructed IT Consultant to create a WhatsApp group of all DHCs at field level, JDH/N, DDH/N, PPO and all Consultants at HQ. DHCs will share their daily work on this app.

Agenda No. 6: Review of Progress of Centre of Excellence.

- a) **CSTF, Ladwa:** DDH, CSTF informed that mango seedlings are in large quantities that can be planted at farmer's field. MD instructed all MS, DHMIUs to lift the mango seedlings as per demand of their districts immediately.
- b) **IBDC, Ramnagar:** DDH, IBDC informed that NOC of Saw machine has not been issued. MD instructed DDH, IBDC to liaison with PCCF, Forest Department Haryana for issue of NOC immediately.
- c) **COE for Horticulture, Sunderha, Narnaul:** Work is under progress at this Centre. MD instructed to expedite the work.
- d) **COE for Horticulture, Hodal, Palwal:** MS, DHMIU Palwal informed that based on the decision taken in previous MIDH meeting, the estimates has been prepared and sent to HQ for further action. MD instructed to put up the case for approval.
- e) **COE for Floriculture, Sondhi, Jhajjar:** The foundation stone of COE for Floriculture is yet to be laid down by Hon'ble CM, Haryana.
- f) **New COE for Horticulture:** MD informed all MS, DHMIUs to identify the land in districts where Centre of Excellence for Horticulture has not been established.
