Agenda No. 3: Component-wise review of progress made under MIDH scheme for the month of July, 2017.

The component-wise physical & Financial expenditure was reviewed by Mission Director. In this regard, MD has directed to all MS, DHMIU that the physical and financial targets should be achieved well in time so that GoI may be requested for release of 2nd installment.

Following decisions were taken during review of components:

3.1 Under the component of Area expansion & Maintenance, IPM/INM & Mechanization, the achievements was low. MD instructed all MS, DHMIUs to complete the targets up to 15th Sept 2017. MD instructed all MS, DHMIUs to ensure the quality of planting material.

3.2 The pending cases of protected cultivation should be verified by the MS, DHMIU of the respective district before forwarding to the HQ. MD instructed to not to exceed the targets under the component of protected structures except for SC families that have been allotted to district. A notice regarding

achievement of targets under Protected Cultivation Component should be displayed on Notice Board.
